Wastepaper

Newspapers, magazines, list, leaflets, wrapping paper, catalogs, cartons, cardboard boxes, cigarette boxes (without foil), writing paper, exercise books, Egg cartons, paper bags, such as flour, sugar, or rolls



Plastic packaging (empty)

Plastic bags and shrink – e.g. for meats and cheeses, wrapping, refill bags, plastic tubes and bottles as for toothpaste or bathing foam, plastic cups e.g. for yoghurt, cream, margarine or quark, tablet packaging, Styrofoam packaging and moulds such as fruit, vegetables, eggs or meat, cardboard coated with plastic or aluminum as for juice or milk



Recycled glass and scrap metal (empty)

Disposable bottles (without deposit), jars, medicine bottles, mustard jars, vinegar, cooking oil, ketchup and salad dressings bottles, spice jars, cans, aerosol cans, aluminum such as yoghurt lids and aluminum trays, biscuit tins, crown caps and screw caps



Biowaste

Organic waste such as fruit and vegetable waste, egg and nutshells, teabags, coffee grounds, spoiled or cooked leftovers in household quantities, remains of flowers (cut and potted flowers), withered plants from the garden, weeds, remains of perennial plants and leaves, lawn cutting, tree and shrub cut in small quantities, hair, feathers and straw



Residual waste

Used toilet articles of all kinds such as diapers, used bandages, vacuum cleaner bags, light bulbs, sweepings, cigarette butts, ceramics, porcelain, plastic products (others than packaging) superimposed cosmetics, ash (cold)



Not for the blue bin

Wallpaper, used household or paper handkerchiefs, coal and carbon paper, CD, DVD, shampoo samples (residual waste)

Not in the yellow bag

Styrofoam ceiling tiles or insulation materials, disposable syringes, other plastic products, video and music cassettes, toys, water pipes, storage baskets (for residual waste)

Not for the recycling bin

Flat glass, crystal glass, ceramic, porcelain, light bulbs (the residual waste), energy saving lamps, fluorescent tubes, electrical devices, cables, enamelled metal (residual waste), lead-based capsules of wine bottles, automobile - or bicycle parts (county landfill, scrap dealers)

Don't put in the compost bin

Raw meat, raw fish, bones and cat litter (for residual waste), food packaging, polythene bags – also no compostable plastic bags (belongs to the individual waste collections), faeces, dead animals, leftovers with animal by-products from the commercial sector (separate disposal required by law!)

Not for the grey bin

Recyclables, harmful substances, organic waste (to the individual collections) electrical devices
